- Consultants Sustrans commissioned (Spring 2019)

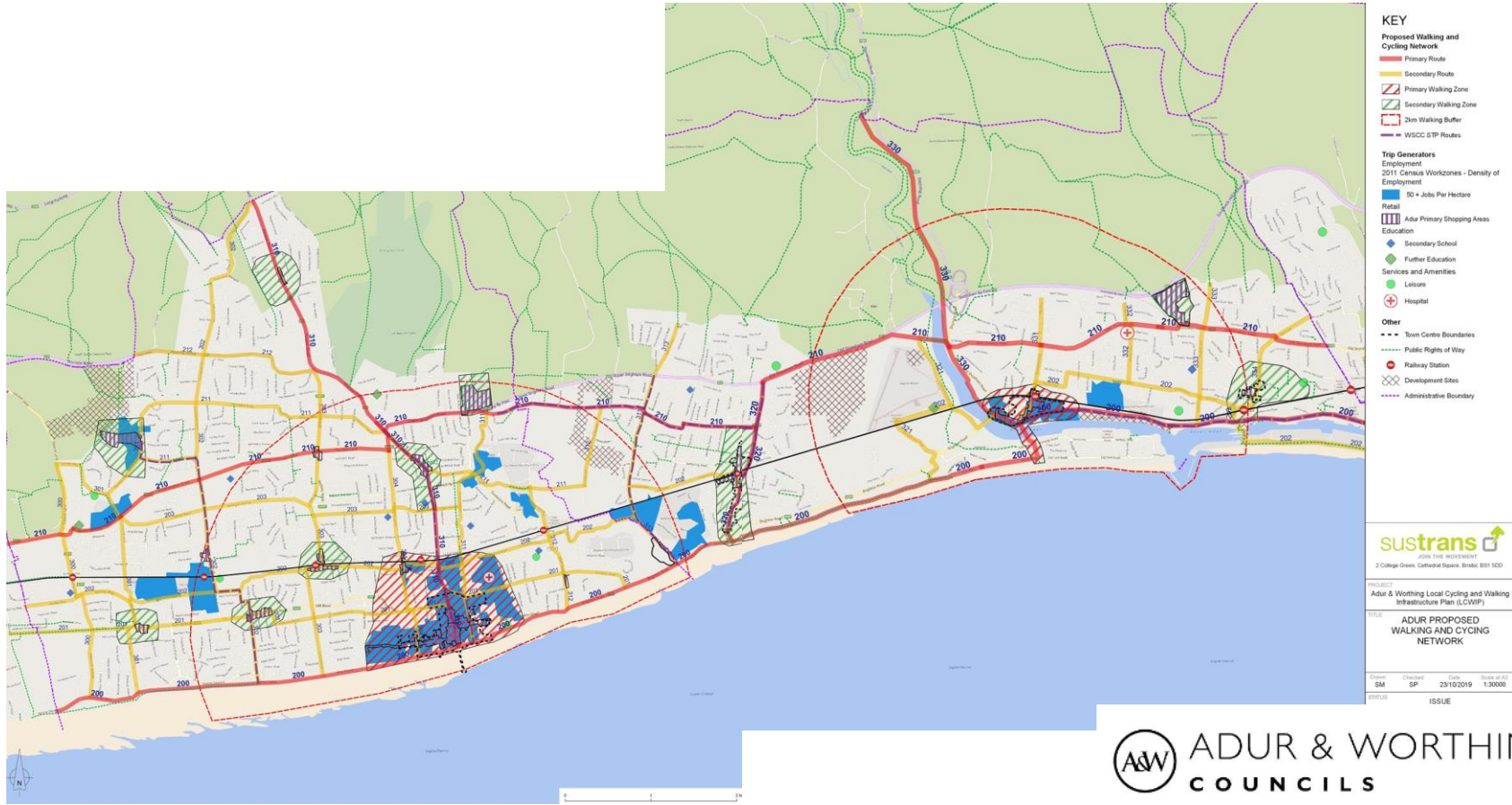
# CONSULTANTS BRIEF

- DRAFT plan produced (autumn 2019)
- Reviewed closely by WSP and WSCC: integrated with WSCC routing and planning
